Report on Wellspring Christmas Fair

November 6th 2018

The Wellspring Annual Christmas Fair took place on the first day of the Causeway Road closure in Broad Chalke – this meant a slow start but this did not last long. The Fair was well attended and there were some excellent stalls and the usual selection of delicious soups and a variety of cheeses.

£1,100 was made for the charity FFRME – this charity was set up by Canon Andrew White the “Vicar of Baghdad”. The money raised will be used to help some of the thousands of people who have returned to their villages on the Nineveh Plain whilst others have fled the country as refugees. As ISIS advanced, these people had fled for their lives, often with babies and young children. They left with nothing, not knowing what the future would hold. Three years later, many have returned and are rebuilding their lives and their communities. These people are brave and have lost everything but they are determined to succeed. FFRME is working with the local churches to help them do so. The money raised will go towards this work.

In addition £300 was raised from Hospice Christmas cards and £306 for Child Link on their stall – Child Link now works with street children in Nepal.

SO, thank you to all who came and supported the Fair and thank you to Jenny Truluck and Team in the kitchen and Charlotte Edwardes and Sarah Panes for organising all the stalls. And with thanks to all the stall holders. Caroline Lamb

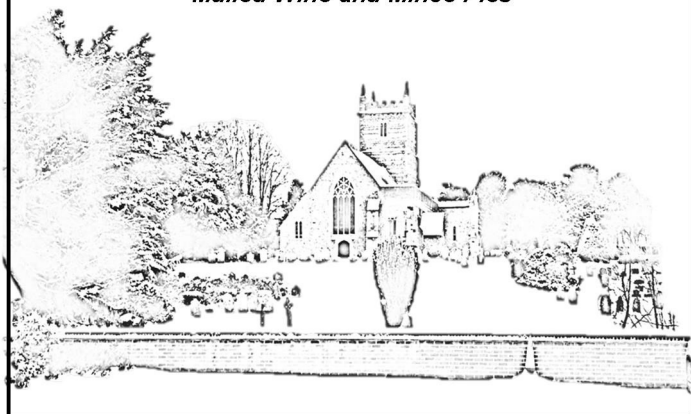
