

I also played the piano and can sing.

#### 4. What colour suits you best?

I am definitely a Blue and Red person and of course Pink, hence my play name 'Dotty Pinkers'

5. So what about travelling Dot, I know you have travelled from Bodenham to Charlton –All –Saints, but where else?

Yugoslavia, Italy, Spain, we travelled quite a lot Jim and I, camping all over Europe. Yes we were really lucky.

#### 6. What are your favourite things to cook Dot, and do you still cook?

Yes on 1<sup>st</sup> January I usually get the Seville's and make marmalade and then there are the Dundee Cakes, I still make them (yes you are famous for your Marmalade and Cakes Dot, I remember being presented with a jar or marmalade from you, our first year in the village...what an honour). And I used to make my own bread, but I don't do that anymore.
