3. What is your biggest achievement?

Acting I suppose, I was a member of the Salisbury Amateur Dramatics Society. I put on a pantomime using local children, it cost 3 or 4 shillings to get in and we performed 2-3 nights at The Radnor Hall and then went on tour to Downton!

I also played the piano and can sing.

4. What colour suits you best?

I am definitely a Blue and Red person and of course Pink, hence my play name 'Dotty Pinkers'

5. So what about travelling Dot, I know you have travelled from Bodenham to Charlton -All -Saints, but where else?

Yugoslavia, Italy, Spain, we travelled quite a lot Jim and I, camping all over Europe. Yes we were really lucky.

6. What are your favourite things to cook Dot, and do you still cook?

Yes on 1st January I usually get the Seville's and make marmalade and then there are the Dundee Cakes, I still make them (yes you are famous for your Marmalade and Cakes Dot, I remember being presented with a jar of marmalade from you, our first year in the village...what an honour). And I used to make my own bread, but I don't do that anymore.
