Odstock Parish Council News

The Annual Parish Meeting was held on Monday 14 May in the Pavilion in Nunton Field, followed by a meeting of the Parish Council.

Annual Parish Meeting

Thank you to everyone who came along and contributed to the discussion. The Parish Council was asked to look at replacing an old gate on the public footpath between Rose Lane and the Dairy with a kissing gate. We also agreed to organise an evening event to enable local people to meet our local Wiltshire Councillor, Richard Clewer, and ask him about his work on our behalf. This will probably be held in September, in the Radnor Hall.

Co-option policy

We agreed to adopt a proposed policy setting out the procedure for co-option of a new councillor to fill a vacant seat on the parish councillor. The final policy can be found on the OPC website.

Playground fence

Three of the posts supporting the picket fence around the playground in Nunton Field are rotting and will need replacing in the near future. The rest of the posts will also have to be replaced in due course. This is probably a job for a fencing contractor, as the old posts are set in concrete and have to be dug out. It is likely to be expensive, and we want to hear your views on whether a fence is actually necessary, as there is no fence around the Odstock children's playground. We could avoid ongoing expenditure by simply removing the picket fence altogether. We are particularly interested to hear from those of you with young children who use the playgrounds. Does the fence serve any important purpose?

Telephone Boxes

British Telecom has told us that the disused telephone box at Bodenham cannot be removed until the electricity supply has been disconnected, which will not be done before next year.

Bus shelters

Several people have contacted us since the last OPC meeting, to say that they would like the wooden bus shelter at Nunton Bridge on the A338 to remain. We have therefore looked into the options for replacing the roof, and decided that the most economic option will be a felt roof, which we can install ourselves.

New Councillor

Welcome to Barry Norris, who has been appointed as a new member of the parish council.

Date of next meeting

The next meeting of OPC will be on 2 July at 7.30 pm, in the Pavilion on Nunton Field. We hope we will see you there.

Great News - we have a new Vicar! Her name is Anna-Claar Thomasson – Rosingh and she will be starting here in the summer. She will be a team vicar for the Chalke Valley with pastoral responsibility for our News and Notes villages. Anna-Claar is married to Keith, and they and their 3 children will live in the Vicarage in Nunton. Anna-Claar works at Sarum college at present and is very much looking forward to living and working among us.

The Licencing service will be in St Andrew's Nunton on Monday 16 July at 7pm and there will be refreshments at the church afterwards.

JOHN AUBREY William Poole

John Aubrey was one of the best-connected scholars and antiquaries in the great decades of the British scientific revolution. A Broad Chalke resident, he was renowned as one of the fathers of English archaeology for his work at Stonehenge and Avebury. Dr William Poole, co-editor of Aubrey's complete correspondences, will provide an expert guide to his many diverse achievements as an all-round virtuoso.

HENRY LAMB Primrose Campbell

Primrose Campbell will outline the turbulent life of her grandfather, the artist Henry Lamb. Raised in an academic household, he was drawn to both medicine and art. As a medical officer in WW1 he won a Military Cross but was intimate with the leading artists of his day and elected a Royal Academician in 1949. Through it all, he loved and painted the scenery of old Wessex, particularly the Chalke Valley.

CECIL BEATON: MALICE IN WONDERLAND Hugo Vickers

Hugo Vickers became Cecil Beaton's authorized biographer at Beaton's request, and was given access to voluminous unpublished material. 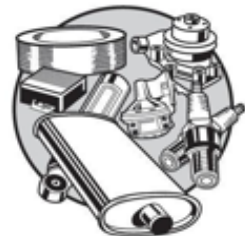
