Chalke Valley Lent Project

Every year we have a Valley Lent Project. By joining together we are able to raise sufficient funds to make a real difference to our chosen charity. This year we have selected the link which our deanery shares with the Diocese of Cueibet in South Sudan, the world's youngest nation, which has struggled with civil war before and since independence in 2013. Over the four years of our link with Cueibet, we have been able to support its people with an agricultural project, a tailoring and sewing business project for women, training for clergy, building a school classroom and launching a radio station.

Cueibet is one of the more remote and deprived areas in South Sudan. There are no metalled roads in the Cueibet area, not even in the towns. In the rainy season the major routes – dirt tracks – can become impassable. The Diocese only owns one vehicle, a motorbike. Bicycles are the best means of travel, whether it be though tracks in the bush or navigating the enormous potholes on the dirt 'roads'. We cannot give everyone a bicycle, but we can begin by helping some of the men and women leaders.

The bicycles are specially designed for Africa, are able to deal with dirt tracks, are super strong to carry heavy loads, with a simple design and available spare parts, keeping them working for many years. They really do change lives, as every day travel and tasks are made more efficient, communication is improved, giving hope and opportunities.
