April looks like having been a busy time for repairs and maintenance of our road network here in South Wiltshire.

At the time of writing these notes, road closures and diversions have been publicised for part of the A338 through Britford during the hours of 1900—0600 from 26th to 28th April for carriageway repairs; the Bodenham Loop Road to be closed during daylight hours for 3 days for road surfacing work and finally, the C12 through Odstock and Nunton has been closed with diversions during April.

The C12 must be the most elusive road in the county judging by the number of times that repair work has been postponed or rescheduled. Originally this much-needed work was due for April 2017.

5th May is a significant date in my diary as I will be standing down from being your Wiltshire Councillor following the election being held the previous day. If nothing else I wanted to witness the completion of the road repairs having spent so much time chasing the Highway's people. It will be a welcome send off gesture!

My thanks for all the support received over the past 24 years that I have been privileged to represent you on the County Council and my best wishes to you all for the future.


Chocolate and Coconut Squares

Temperature - 190c

Cooking time - 40 minutes

Serves - 10-12



Ingredients

450g Plain chocolate

220g Butter

3 Large eggs

2 tbsp Strong coffee

1 tsp Vanilla essence

225g Caster sugar

75g Self raising flour

25g Cocoa powder

½ tsp Salt

50g Shredded coconut

150 White chocolate drops

Method

- 1 Preheat oven 190c. Lightly oil and line a brownie tin.
- 2 Break the plain chocolate and chop the butter into small pieces and melt in a bowl over simmering water. Allow to cool for 10 minutes.
- 3 Beat together the eggs, black coffee, vanilla essence and sugar. Gradually add the melted chocolate.
- 4 Sift together the flour, cocoa and salt, and fold in using a metal spoon along with the coconut and white chocolate drops.
- 5 Spoon into the prepared tin and bake for 40 minutes until just firm to touch. Do not overcook – they should be gooey when cooled.
- 6 Leave to cool in the tin, then turn out and cut into squares.
- 7 Store in an airtight container for up to 1 week if they last that long!

1. If you could live anywhere in the world, where would it be and why?

Another choice would be Leonard Cohen; he was in the studio where I was working one afternoon, and he was a great storyteller with a mischievous sense of humour.

5. Which season of the year is your favourite and why?

Much as I truly love autumn for the colours (and the fact that you're not forever holding out hope for a great summer) my favourite time of year is the early spring. Coming out of the monochrome gloom of winter, it's uplifting to see all the life and colour suddenly flourish as the days get longer, and I guess I'm more aware of it since living in the countryside.


