Emma & Chris moved into Nunton in late 2017 and here are some questions and answers below so we can get to know them...

You moved to Nunton in November 2017, so how long have you lived in the area and where did you grow - up?

I'm Salisbury born and bred. I spent my younger years in the York Road area – and can remember when Waitrose used to be a Live-stock Market. I'm pretty sure there was a dance academy above it – which my Nan used to drag me along to!! (Emma).

I moved to Salisbury from London in 1992. I grew up on the coast in Christchurch and went to Twyneham Comp (Chris).

What do you like about living in Nunton so far?

I really like the 'feel' of Nunton. The people we've met so far have been incredibly friendly and welcoming – it already feels like we're part of a community. I also like the fact that we're within walking distance of the pubs!! (Emma).

Feeling like you are in the country but also still very close to Salisbury with easy access to the forest, coast and local walks (to pubs!). Everyone has been very welcoming, and you can sense a real community spirit. A good pub helps, and I also like the milk dispenser, so you can support the local farmer (Chris).

Which book, film, piece of music or place in the world inspires you most and why?

Probably anywhere on top of a mountain or in a pub after an all-day walk in the hills – Snowdon, Yorkshire Peaks etc. I like the feeling of freedom, the expanse of countryside that you see and the sense of achievement (Chris).

What style of food is your favourite and where is your favourite place to eat?

I don't really have a favourite – I like Anokaa in Salisbury or anywhere on the coast – I hear that champagne goes well with fish and chips on the beach! (Chris).

Sport. do you participate, watch or try to avoid? Which and why?

Horse racing has been a passion in my family for years. When I was younger, my family had a Bookies on York Road. My parents went on to have shares in several racehorses over the years and my youngest son works in the horse racing industry. I'd be lying if I said I shared my family's passion for horse racing - but I derive a lot of pleasure from the things my son does / has done within the industry. Oh – and I'm quite a bit Liverpool fan (I've seen them win the FA Cup twice) (Emma)

Strangely enough Emma and I both come from families who used to be bookmakers including my Dad, Grandad and Great Grandad. I have little interest in horse racing. I am a rugby fan and support Bath and England. We are in the process of booking to go to the Rugby World Cup in Japan in 2019(Chris).

If you had to describe your personality as a cartoon character or superhero, who would you be and why?

Probably someone from the Wacky Races as I have been known to drive too fast! (Chris).

Name 3 guests you would like at your dinner table (past or Present) and why?

My Mum – she passed away (unexpectedly) a couple of years ago and I miss her every day

God – although I don't believe he exists (sorry – bit controversial), if he rocked up I've got a lot of questions for him

Rod Stewart – someone needs to provide the entertainment and, boy, has that man got some stories to tell

Davina McCall – I don't know why but I think she'd be good fun / company (and I could pick up some fitness tips from her – she looks amazing for her age)

(I know that's 4 people but I'm banking on God not turning up ...) (All Emma)

Stephen Fry – very bright, good story teller and should be prime minister!

Muhammad Ali at the age of about 25 – what a sportsman and very amusing.

Tom Hardy – I would be intrigued to meet him – good actor and appears to be an interesting character (All Chris – a bit odd that they are all men!)

Where in the world is your favourite holiday destination or place you would like to travel to?

I've been fortunate enough to go on some lovely holidays – but would say that my favourite destination (so far) has been South Africa. It's such a diverse country - there's so much to see and do. I'd absolutely love to go back (Emma)
