The talk for the day was 'Bless This Child' by Val Proctor, who rescues old christening gowns to preserve the workmanship and history of them. After being given a few by a friend she decided to collect more, and research them, so that she could share them with others. She began with a short history of christening traditions, from the early swaddling bands and bearing cloths to the gowns of the Victorian and Edwardian period and the present day.

We were then allowed to handle her collection of beautiful old gowns which illustrated examples of exquisite embroidery, lace, pleating and broderie anglaise on very fine cotton. Many members had also brought in a lovely selection of their own family christening gowns for the ACWW competition, which was won by Stella Flux.

The next meeting, 'Nature's Magical Moments', is on 13th February at 10.00am at the Radnor Hall, and visitors are welcome.
